Activity Report 2013-14

1. Banking Club activities

A. TRAINING PROGRAM

B. FINANCIAL INCLUSION CAMPAIGN

In association with College of Agricultural Banking RBI, Pune and under the guidance of Mr.Thomas Punnot GM, CAB the banking club has conducted financial inclusion campaign in village Garade, Taluka Purandar during NSS camp in three parts. Discussion with villagers in the context of need of farmers club to improve their financial conditions through group marketing, Audio-Visual session with the students on financial inclusion, Interview with the branch manager of Bank Of India regarding the banking habits of the Garade villagers. The

club has also sponsored suggestion box to gather the suggestions and complaints regarding banking and business related issues.

C.VISIT TO FARMER'S CLUB

Along with the Sarpanch of Garade village and few villagers, students and some faculties the club had visited to the village located at MANN near Hinjawadi to see and discuss the working of farmer's club and to initiative the same concept in the Garade village. Abhinav Farmer's Club started by Mr. Bodke motivated and the villagers to start farmer's club. Banking club proposed farmer's club of the village MANN to put up a stall at Vividha Exhibition to showcase the various agricultural produce and their efforts towards group marketing.

D.BANKING LITRACY MISSION

In association with COSMOS Bank, Sanewadi branch the club had initiated banking and financial literacy mission by directing the first year students towards opening a bank account and pan card at college campus. The student's banking habits were monitored and directed wherever it is essential.

E.EFFORT OF NO-VEHICAL DAY

The members of the banking club had initiated the No-Vehicle Day on the occasion of very burning issue of Dollars V/S Rupees in the month of August. It protected the environment as well as economy by saving the use of fuel on that day as well as it created awareness amongst the students.

On 5th March 'Insurance Awareness' discussion was arranged to educate the T.Y.Bcom students about the importance of insurance and care to be taken while continuing contract with insurance company. The session resource person was Mr.Sumed Mokhale, Development officer of Life Insurance Company of India.13 students of banking participated in intercollegiate Paper presentation on Insurance in INDSEARCH [Management Institute].

H.ON THE JOB TRAINING PROGRAM

Every year on-the-job training program is arranged for T.YBcom students of Banking and Finance in collaboration with Vidya Sahakari Bank ltd in its various branches. This is the 5th

year of the training program. About 55 students have participated in the training program out of which 42 students got the excellent remark.
