Discussion and Approval of the Syllabi of Second Year B. A. (English) and Second Year BSc-English (Regular and Computer Science)

 The proposed syllabus of SYBA English and Second Year BSc-English (Regular and Computer Science) was presented before the BoS members.



 It was recommended that number of credits, lectures, tutorials, and practicals be mentioned in the curriculum wherever required.

 It was suggested by subject expert Dr. Atul Patil, and Industry expert Mr. Yogesh Borate, to make certain additions and modifications in SYBA Compulsory English, SEC – 1A and SEC -2A curricula.

Minutes of the Meeting:

- The Chair welcomed the members and gave a review of the previous BOS meeting that was held.
- 2. A review of how the First year syllabus was being implemented was shared.
- 3. Chair proposed to the BOS Members the first change that was introducing Psychology of Adjustment in place of Psychology of Abnormal Behaviour. These were the responses of the members:
 - This change will cater to offering relevant information rather than just putting forth the glamor of disorders.
 - It is a better approach to teach the subject, introduce some disorders, not entire focus on disorders, balance of adjustment and disorders.
 - The change is welcome and it is a good idea to introduce Psychology of Adjustment.
 - A small introduction to Pathology will be enough to give students an idea for Clinical Masters.



- This subject has a broader applicability to students. They will learn disorders in Masters and this will better prepare them for adjustment for life.
- There is more to Psychology than disorders. Adjustment Psychology will bridge the gap between FY to SY.
- Focus of Abnormal Psychology is only symptoms and a holistic approach are missing thus introducing this subject will be good.
 There was a consensus about the proposed change among the members.
- 4. The second point that the Chair brought up for discussion was replacing the Positive Psychology paper with Gender and Psychology.

The Conclusions from the discussion were as follows:

- This will be an amazing course for General students. There is a desperate need for Gender sensitization in an academic setting.
- · Gender dynamics in workplace can be addressed with this course
- How will this paper be different from the gender aspect in the adjustment paper? Mainstream approach will be taken in adjustment and gender psychology will take the critical approach.
- · Overlap will be avoided in both papers.
- It becomes difficult in teaching and paper setting if there is overlap in syllabus. Application can be made in adjustment paper.
- Applications of this paper will be across subjects and it is important to discuss gender and all its aspects.

MA Part II Syllabus

- The Chair brought up for discussion that in the Paper Psychopathology there should be an addition of the Topics - History of the Anti-Psychiatry Movement, and UNCRPD.
 - This will be an introduction to International Psychology and familiarize them with Users Movement, Anti-Psychiatry frames, and the WHO released Quality Rights in Mental Health.
 - Introductory to re fashion Clinical Psychology. It falls in Public Health Domain.
 - For jobs, clinical research, counselling, students need to know about alternative movements and move out of Mainstream Psychology.
 - "Compliments on this addition, I am sure the students will rise up to this syllabus and do it justice."
 - We need to include this to offer students a broader understanding of Mental Health.



- Prof. Swati Kandharkar, Chairperson, Mathematics BOS recommended new evaluation pattern to include project work.
- Prof. Sanjay Dhole suggested that Certificate Course should be for two credits, so the Certificate Course designed by Zoology BOS needs to be upgraded to two credits. He also suggested that under NEP 2020, Multiple Entry-Exit Mechanism would be applicable where a student gets certificate after completing first year of the course. In view of that, it is advisable to change the nomenclature of a Certificate Course to Value-added or Add-on Course so as to avoid any confusion. He stated that under CBCS system, all BOS would create a uniform structure in which core courses will have 70% weightage & mobility will be provided in 30% element. Elective Value-added courses need to be open for all.
- Prof. Rajeshwari Deshpande suggested that uniformity in the nomenclature of courses & parity of
 credits (All course to be of two credits) need to be ensured. She urged to have a dialogue across all
 BOS. She also alcred that not to float too many courses rather she advised to have a manageable
 structure of the syllabus from a point of view of teachers and students.

The members approved the minutes of all above mentioned BOS.

3. Approval of minutes of Board of Interdisciplinary Studies: Principal Dr.Sanjay Kharat informed the council members about formation of a separate Board of Studies for Interdisciplinary studies. Meeting of Board of Interdisciplinary Studies was organized on 18th of October 2022 in which it was decided to implement certain mandatory credit courses.

5. Any other point with the permission of the chair:

- 5.1 Dr.Adinath Suryakar suggested that action taken report appended with minutes of previous meeting update the members about decisions taken and their status. It was decided to share action taken report along with a notice of next meeting.
- 5.2 Prof. Swati Kandharkar, Chairperson, Mathematics BOS and a member discussed the issue of Mathematics required or omitted to fulfill Eligibility for the courses like BCA (Science), Biotechnology & BSc Blended There are modules based on mathematics for the above mentioned courses, however students who didn't opt Mathematics find it difficult. Despite organizing Bridge Courses the student can't get good marks in Mathematics. It was suggested that the BOS decides about the eligibility for above mentioned courses. Prof. Deshpande advised that such eligibility related criteria need to be defined in accordance with the AICTE and UGC norms

The meeting was concluded with a cordial vote of thanks.
