Merit forms for M. Sc.(I) Organic chemistry are available online on college website www.moderncollegegk.org.

Total number of seats available are 44. Reservations for all categories will be followed as per Govt. of Maharashtra rules only for candidates of Maharashtra state. 4 seats are available for students of other universities on the basis of merit.

Important dates

Last date of submission of merit form	2 nd July 2016 till 2.00 pm
Declaration of Merit list	5 th July 2016 till 4.00 pm
In case of any error in the merit list, the candidate should report, in writing, to the Head, Dept. of Chemistry	on or before 7 th July 2016 till 3.00pm
Counseling for admission	11 th July 2016 reporting at 11.30 am . The counseling will start at 12.00 noon
Last date of payment of fee	13 th July 2016 till 1.00 pm
The 2 nd round for the vacant seats	15 th July at 1.00 pm in the Dept. of Chemistry only for those who are present in the counseling session on 11 th July 2016.

The Student MUST bring following documents (Original and one attested copy) at the time of counseling:

1. F.Y., S.Y. and T.Y. B.Sc. mark sheets
2. Leaving certificate of previously attended institute.
3. Gap certificate (if required)
4. Caste Certificate from Government of Maharashtra (if applicable)
5. Caste Validity Certificate from Government of Maharashtra (if applicable)
6. Non-creamy layer certificate from Government of Maharashtra (if applicable)

NOTE: Failure to show any of the above mentioned documents may result in the cancellation of admission.

- Only reservation category candidate certified as having domicile in the state of Maharashtra are eligible for the 50 % reserved seats.
- As soon as the admissions for the available seats are completed, the admission procedure will be stopped and further session of the counseling will be cancelled.
